Dear Kids Kuts Voorhees Families,

As many of you know, I have closed the salon until October 27, 2020, due to a COVID-19 exposure.

The Camden County Department of Health has informed me the exposure occurred on TUESDAY, October 13, 2020, after 3:30 PM. On this day, one stylist and five families were exposed, which includes seven children. We believe all persons were wearing a mask as per our procedures.

I have been working closely with a DOH representative; those affected have been contacted via phone by me and will be receiving a phone call from the Camden County Department of Health within the next day or two.

Today, I have hired a sanitizing company that will come to the salon early next week. The company uses a TouchPoint Disinfectant and will Fog with an EPA Registered, List N, Hospital Grade Disinfectant. The product is a unique nature-inspired blend, plant-based antimicrobial. This product cleans, disinfects & deodorizes all in one and leaves no residue, is low in toxicity, and has no harsh fumes. We will also have our heater filters changed, all capes and towels washed in addition to the floor professionally cleaned, as we have every other Sunday for five years.

I spoke to all the stylists today, and we all agreed to get tested before returning to work. Testing includes myself and my two daughters that work as receptionists at our small family-owned business. As a parent, I understand your fears and promise you we have been trying hard to have strict safety practices since reopening in June. Safety must come before anything else.

I sincerely appreciate all the kind words of support many of you have sent. The appointments that have booked are a blessing and tells me we can survive this. Your patience, kindness, and understanding help me stay positive, and I will not stop fighting for the salon, the staff, and our KKV community.
